## Reception and Nursery

### What are my tasks today?

## TUESDAY

- Go on a Spring walk outside, your challenge is to find what is happening outside to show that the season is changing. Can you spot any leaf buds on trees? Any bulbs pushing out of the soil? Can you find any early blossom on trees? Can you spot any snowdrops? What about lambs in nearby fields or small insects? Make a list of what you have found with your grown up and talk about how Winter changes into Spring.
- Take 10 coins, buttons or counting objects, how many different ways can you share them into two groups? 1 and 9 make 10, 2 and 8 make 10 etc. Record all the different ways by using drawings or writing. If you still have your first pack resources, there will be a rectangle with ten squares on it (a ten frame), how could you use that to show your answers?
- Nursery children - practise writing your first name with a capital letter at the start.
- Reception children - practise writing your first name and surname with a capital letter at the start of each word.
- This week we will be talking about the Moon, but Mars has been in the news a lot recently. Find out 5 facts about Mars. You can write the facts in your green book and draw some pictures to illustrate them.

## Marvellous Maths

- Together task: Bring two small cups to the learning session on a tray or on something to prevent spills. Fill one cup full of water and the other nearly empty.
- Listening task: We are going to continue our measurement work. Learning the meaning of 'full' and 'not full' with Concept Cat.
- Thinking task: Is your cup full? drink from your cup. Is it full now? Not full/nearly full? Drink some more, nearly empty, finish the water, now empty!

### Complete the activity

Fill 2 cups of water and label them with the words 'full' and 'not full'. Then try filling 4 cups of water and label them with 'full', 'nearly full', 'nearly empty' and 'empty'. Finally, on the Capacity sheet with today's date, colour in the glasses with the correct amount of water so they match their label.

Find out three interesting facts about the moon for tomorrow's learning session. What does it look like? What can you hear on the moon? Does it have any people or animals? What about water or air?
