- The first question will be easier than the second, as you should 'find and copy' (Retrieve) from the text. The second question will always test one of the other reading skills above e.g. define, infer, predict. **There might also be a challenge question on certain days** (but you should only do this if you like a reading challenge 😊)
- Page numbers refer to pages on the scanned text, not the page in your home learning pack.
