Class Dojo

We will be continuing to use Class Dojo - if you have a problem accessing your child's details (points earned etc) or cannot see any class stories / school stories, please do not hesitate to ask for help.

Homework

Your child will receive a Homework Overview based around a curriculum area each half term. It will explain the choices for home learning that should take place and one piece should be returned via Class Dojo Portfolio each week. Full details will be on the Homework Overview and work will be celebrated each week.

Each half term, your child will also receive a half termly spelling list. This shows which spellings your child will be tested on each week. These spellings should be practiced regularly for the weekly spelling test.

Weekly homework should also include time to work on TT Rockstar and ReadTheory. Even 10 minutes a day will have a hugely positive impact on your child's learning.

Times Table Rockstar

Your child has an account on Times-Table Rockstars and should be practicing regularly to increase their recall and rock speed. Training in the 'Garage' area of the site can also earn virtual coins and helps in gaining confidence. Here is the direct link to the website: ttrockstars.com

In addition, you will also be able to support your child in recalling mathematical facts, as they will be receiving a maths focus that they will be tested on weekly.

My Happy Mind

Year 6 Summer Curriculum 2021

<u>English/Guided Reading:</u> In English, we will be finishing our book The Good Thieves by Katherine Rundell.

For Guided Reading we will be starting a new class text called 'The Great Elephant Chase' by Gillian Cross, where Tad and Cissie travel across the USA with Khush the elephant.

<u>Non-fiction:</u> We will be reading a variety of texts, with a focus on the United States of America, as well as studying the poetry of Edgar Allan Poe

<u>Maths:</u> We will be continuing to work on developing our basic skills and fluency as well as studying position and direction and ratio and proportion. This will be followed by an introduction to statistics.

We will also be undertaking an additional maths session for the first half term.

<u>Science</u>: This half term, we will be discovering all about the Linnaeus classification system. We will be creating and using classification keys to show how the animal kingdom can be divided into different subsets.

<u>Geography:</u> We will be continuing our virtual trip around the U.S.A. and looking at the West Coast of the country. Later on in the topic, we will be finding out about lines of latitude and longitude as well as 6-figure grid references.

<u>PE:</u> In PE we will be learning basketball skills as well as exploring some new outdoor adventurous activities. In the second half term we will be moving on to learning tennis skills.

<u>RE:</u> We will be exploring Christianity and the themes of rescue and salvation.

<u>Music</u>: In music we will continue to look at the music styles that came out of America in the last 100 years.

<u>Art/DT:</u> We will be studying the American artist Georgia O'Keefe.

<u>French:</u> In French, we will be learning about where we live. This will include describing where we are from and learning
