1	<p align="center"><u>Science - Evolution and Inheritance</u></p> <p>In this lesson, we will learn what the fossil record has taught us about the history of organisms that have existed on our planet. We will learn what a geologist is and what they can tell us about the organisms that have lived during each geological era of time. 2	<p align="center"><u>Computing - Flat file databases</u></p> <p>In this lesson you will use a database on a computer. You will sort data to answer question.
